**Science:** We are currently studying about the Earth's Water Systems. This week, we looked at where water comes from when turning on the faucet. Students learned about aquifers. In our project, students determined the best place to settle a new town by considering its access to water. They looked at landscape, topography and vegetation to make an informed decision as a team.
